Minutes of the 9th Meeting of Sub-committee of NCVT on "Norms & Courses" held on 5th July, 2018 at 3rd Floor, Kaushal Bhawan, Pusa Road, Karol Bagh, New Delhi.

The 9th meeting of the 'Sub-committee of NCVT on Norms and Courses" was held on 5th July, 2018 at 3rd Floor, Kaushal Bhawan, Pusa Road, Karol Bagh, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Shri Vijay Kumar Dev, Director General (Training)/Additional Secretary to Government of India, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship. List of participants who attended the meeting is placed at **annex-I.**

The Chairman extended his heartiest welcome to all the members, attending the meeting with brief about the constitution and proceedings of the committee on 'norms and courses'. Further, he advised DDG (C, P & Admin) to take up the agenda items one by one for discussions.

Agenda Item No.1: Action Taken Report (ATR) on the recommendations made during meeting of Sub-Committee on "Norms and Courses" held on 23rd March, 2018 at New Delhi.

Action Taken Report (ATR) on the recommendations made during meeting of Sub-Committee on "Training norms and courses" held on 23rd March, 2018 was reviewed by all the hon'ble members and had no observation so approval was accorded to ATR.

Agenda Item No.2: Approval of introduction of new trades under Craftsmen Training Scheme.

The Chairman appreciated the steps taken by DGT as well CSTRAI towards introduction of new courses on Internet of Things etc. The members pointed out that these courses should be NSQF aligned.

In this context, it was advised to CSTRAI to submit the proposal(s) for NSQF compliance to NSDA at the earliest to consider the proposals in the NSDA' ensuing meeting scheduled on 13.07.2018. The DDG, NSDA was also of opinion and in favour to consider these proposals in the NSQC' meeting. The committee has its in-principal approval to start these courses but to be aligned with NSQF as early as possible. Members highlighted the issue of time required for purchase of equipment and in process of grant of affiliations. In this regards as there are common tools and equipment of trade electronics mechanic (1st Semester), so that aspirational institutes may start courses with the condition of obtaining affiliation from NCVT within 6 months i.e. upto December 2018.

Agenda Item No.3: Approval of following 5 High employment potential courses under Flexi MoU under Craftsmen Training Scheme.

The Executive from the K.K. Techno Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Dhanbad gave its presentation for better clarity of the mining courses especially designed for the dependents of the affected people. The Committee appreciated the steps taken towards the mining sector which was hitherto neglected in terms of Skill training primarily owing to higher costs of the machinery & equipment of mining.

The committee again highlighted the issue of NSQF alignment of these courses. It was unanimously decided to 1st get NSQF alignment of these courses for future career point of the passing out trainees and follow the process of NSQF compliance in future. The DDG, NSDA suggested that for courses not funded by Govt of India, exemption may be sought from NSDA for NSQF compliance.

Agenda Item no. 4 : Approval of 46 NSQF aligned CTS courses for conducting training from session starting from August, 2018

The committee took a brief of 46 NSQF aligned courses and accorded approval.

Agenda Item no. 5 : Approval of Agenda: Guidelines for granting autonomous Status to Private ITIs .

The committee appreciated the efforts taken by Ms. Anita Srivastava, JDT towards formulation of guidelines (analogous to UGC etc.) for granting autonomous

status to Pvt. ITIs. The matter was discussed at length by the members with mix reactions considering pros and cons for future point of view. The Members showed apprehensions of misuse in future, if implemented without proper, fool proof guidelines and at the same time raised the question of observations submitted by the all states (Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Delhi, CII and NCW) to whom guidelines were issued. In this regard, it was highlighted that these draft guidelines should be circulated further to all States/UTs for comments within 15-20 days. These observations, expected from States/UTs would be placed in the next meeting of Subcommittee of NCVT for norms and courses.

Additional Points

The Deputy Director, DET Karnataka raised the issue of very low admissions in the trade Welder due to enhancement of the entry qualification from 8th class passed to 10th. In response, the Officers from CSTRAI gave the background/logic for enhancement of qualification that the Industry was not taking welders passing out from ITIs with 8th class qualification for various reasons.

Concluding all the points, the Chairman advised the officer, DET Karnataka to submit all related data (admission and employment etc.- Welder trade) to CSTRAI to take further decision in this regard and submit the proposal in the next meeting of Sub-Committee on norms and courses.

Shri. P.C. Bhandari, from JK Institute highlighted the various problems coming on the way of implementation of the Dual Training System. In this regard, the Chairman advised DDG to constitute a dedicated team to resolve the matter at the earliest and conduct a meeting with in 15 days preferably at the location of Institute which has adopted dual system of training.

Sh. Sushil Agarwal, DDT, DGT HQ raised the point that best practices being adopted by some of the States like Monitoring of placement data and development of app for admission of ITIs should be brought to the notice of the sub committees of the NCVT for appreciation and sharing with States/UTs as an encouragement.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
