The meeting of Recommendation Committee (RC) on 'Norms & Courses' was held under the chairmanship of Shri Rajesh Aggarwal, (DG)T/AS, DGT on  $03^{rd}$  December, 2019 at Conference Room, 1st Floor, PUSA Complex, New Delhi. List of the participants who attended the meeting is placed at Annex – 1.

The DDG (C,P & Admn), DGT, Shri Deepankar Mallick extended heartiest welcome to all the members and thereafter Shri G. Giri, Joint Director set the tone of meeting with starting action taken report of previous meeting of RC.

# Action Taken Report (ATR) on the recommendations made during meeting of Recommendation Committee on "Norms and Courses" held on 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 at New Delhi.

Action taken report (ATR) on the recommendations made during the meeting were reviewed by committee members and suggested to take further action on the following agenda points.

**Agenda no. 11 :** 25 % reservation by for direct admission to CITS by State sponsored instructors will be discontinued permanently due to introduction of RPL scheme under CITS. Accordingly necessary order to be issued to State Govt /UTs.

**Agenda no. 14:** Simplified draft guideline for opening ITI in polytechnic was discussed and further instructions given as follows:

- i. The draft guideline is to be circulated to all concern.
- ii. The previous year affiliated polytechnics are to be inspected on sample basis to ascertain their performance. Thereafter the draft guideline is to be modified and put up for discussion in next meeting.

Additional Points of Recommendation Committee on "Norms and Courses" held on 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 at New Delhi.

- a) CITS review committee report to be finalized and circulated by Director CFI for further action.
- b) Revision of power norms by the committee headed by Sh. Mihir Parial, Ex-Director TC has to be completed and report may be submitted.
- c) Possibility of part time ITI classes for non-attending candidates in NSTI and ITIs may be explored. Detail proposal may be submitted by Director, CD DGT.
- 1. Agenda Item No.1: Restructuring of all QP files/ syllabi by CSTARI for CTS, CITS, Advanced diploma (Vocational) and Flexi MoUs without changing of learning outcomes.

## Agenda no 3: Revival of deleted trade Data Entry Operator and Driver CUM Mechanic under CTS.

Shri G.Giri, JDT, CD section explained to members that trade 'Data Entry Operator' and 'Driver CUM Mechanic' had been discontinued in the list of CTS/ purview of NCVT from the session August, 2015. DG/AS, DGT briefed to members a details to revive of above both 6 months trades and advised to Director, CSTARI, to modify syllabus of Data Entry Operator slightly and submit to DGT quickly so that information can be timely communicated to State Directorates/UTs to start the session w.e.f 16<sup>th</sup> January, 2019. DDG, (C,P & Admn), requested to DG/AS, DGT that DGT shall also start course duration of 6 month for heavy vehicle. DG/AS described to members that NSDC has explored vocational training in area of heavy vehicle. However, we may start such type courses in Dohraha, Ludhiana with collaboration of NSDC. DG/AS, DGT directed to Director, CFI to prepare a proposal.

# Agenda no. 04: Deletion/discontinue 'Old Age Care' and Pre/Preparatory School Management Assistant' from the list of CTS.

Committee approved that No further affiliation, addition of unit to be granted for the trade Old Age Care and Pre/Preparatory Management Assistant (Early Childhood Educator") hence forth. Accordingly, Director TC is advised to take necessary action w.e.f 2020.

## Agenda 7. : Equivalency of COE trades with CTS trades.

The concept of CoE and its proposed equivalency was explained to the members by Shri G.Giri, Joint Director, CD. Considering the complexity and gravity of issue, DG/AS, DGT has suggested to circulate this draft proposal of equivalency to all members and state govts/UTs dealing skill development program. It was further suggested to discuss the above proposal with the 5 states (Odisha, Tripura , Kerala, Assam and Tamilnadu) who are continuing implementation and get the feed back. The special meeting may be convened to address this issue.

Additional Agenda : MoU between NSTI Bhubaneswar and Centurion University of Technology and Management (CUTM), Odisha for recognition of Credit Framework between CUTM and NSTI including launch of Joint B.Voc Programme for CTS/CITS graduates.

The members of the meeting were apprised about the proposal for piloting of B.Voc programme at NSTI, Bhubaneshwar in collaboration with Centurion University of Technology and Management (CUTM), Bhubaneshwar.

The members deliberated on various aspects of the proposal and agreed that piloting of such B.Voc programmes is an important step towards creating pathways for upward mobility of students in ITI eco system and development of credit transfer framework with multiple entry and exit points. This will also result in making ITI ecosystem more aspirational, specially for youth who intend the pursue degree programmes.

It was recommended that the same shall be taken forward.

### > Additional Points.

During discussion and deliberation following additional points were discussed and decision taken:

- It was brought to be notice of the Recommendation Committee that after admission in ITI either the students admitted in the particular trade is found fit for the trade or interested to change the trade. Some ITI/States are not allowing the change. Hence after discussion it was decided before closer of final admission the changes may be allowed with in the ITI or across the ITI of the state subject to vacancies of the seats. However, the mechanism of change of trades of the candidate may be decided by the respective state department dealing with Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS).
- 2. A New course for e-vehicle under CTS may be designed. However, Director CSTARI expressed that some content have been incorporated in existing 2/3 wheeler curriculum and a new curricula for e-vehicle will be developed soon.
- 3. There are some 6 months courses under CTS which are run once in a year i.e. w.e.f August, due to restriction in NCVT MIS Portal maintained by Wipro resulting in un-utilization of workshops for another 6 months. Hence after deliberation it was decided the all 6 month course under CTS to be run twice in a year i.e. session starting from 1<sup>st</sup> August to 15<sup>th</sup> January and 16<sup>th</sup> January to 30<sup>th</sup> June.
- 4. The batch size for all Advanced Diploma (Vocational) should be 20 except 'Advanced Diploma (Vocational) IT networking and Cloud'. 'Advanced Diploma (Vocational) IT networking and Cloud' should be 30.
- 5. Entry qualification for all Advanced Diploma (Vocational) should be NTC/ NAC in relevant trades or Polytechnic and Engineering except Advanced Diploma

(Vocational) IT networking and cloud and 'Advanced Diploma (Vocational) Welding Technology'. For 'Advanced Diploma (Vocational) Welding Technology' entry qualification will be NTC and NAC in welding related trades.

For 'Advanced Diploma (Vocational) IT networking and Cloud' Entry qualification should be X/XII Std pass with NTC (NCVT certificate in relevant trade) of any one year or Two-year Trade.

#### or

XII Std pass with minimum 60% marks/First Class.

### or

X std pass with three-year diploma from recognized board.

or

Any regular degree from recognized university.

- 6. 80 hours syllabus for Employability Skills for 6 month courses are to be redesigned by CSTARI, by modifying previous 55 hours course.
- 7. In some trade under CTS entry qualification is mentioned passed 10<sup>th</sup> examination with science and maths. After deliberation it was decided that 10<sup>th</sup> pass with science and math will be allowed in admission even if some candidate failed in science or math provided respective Board of examination issued the 10<sup>th</sup> pass certificate.
- 8. The representative from Maruti Suzuki requested to grant equivalency of Flexi MoU courses with CTS courses to full fill the aspiration of candidates for Govt. Jobs which are presently advertised for NTC (ITI) holders. As per the guidelines of Flexi MoU the courses are specific to the Industry and passed out candidate are to be absorbed in that industry. Hence after deliberation it was not accepted in the meeting.
- 9. For CTS courses under DST mode two certificates should be issued. One regular NTC and another separate certificate mentioning the industry where the candidates have under gone the OJT training.
