3. CBT Exam Pattern: There will be two examination sessions consisting of three/ two papers for Engineering/Non-Engineering trade respectively.

Engineering trades:



Exam-1: Trade Theory - 50 questions, 100 marks

Exam-2: Workshop Calculation & Science (WCS) - 25 questions, 50 marks and
Employability Skills (ES) - 25 questions, 50 marks

Non-Engineering trades:

Exam-1: Trade Theory - 50 questions, 100 marks

Exam-2: Employability Skills (ES) - 25 questions, 50 marks

4. CBT Examination Fee: Apprentices are required to pay the fee while registering for exam through online mode only. The fee paid is non-refundable. The functionality for fee payment is integrated in apprentice login. The fee is as below:
