

In its reply the ITI submitted the following:</p> <p>a. <u>Main deficiency noted:</u> The ITI has operated since 2022 without an electric meter, relying entirely on a 9.1 kW solar power system (generator/solar panel) for the entire institute.</p> <p>b. <u>Clarification:</u> The ITI has an active electric connection (Consumer/Account No. 151202093 / 120214038138) alongside the solar system.</p> <p>c. <u>Proof submitted:</u> Latest electricity bill attached ("bill details of iti.pdf", 742 KB) to verify the electric connection and meter.</p> <p>d. <u>Request:</u> If the committee has any concerns about operations, electricity connection, or overall compliance, conduct a re-inspection to verify all required norms.</p>	<p>from the issuance of the minutes of that meeting.</p> <p>2. The ITI, however, submitted the reply but the reply was found not satisfactory. The ITI accepted itself in its reply that it is running without a Electricity connection since year 2022, which is a serious violation of affiliation norms.</p> <p>Therefore, in view of the interest of the trainees and the continuous violations of the affiliation norms, the ITI is hereby de-affiliated.</p>

The date of inspection shall be decided by the State Directorate in consultation with RDSDE Rajasthan. The inspection report shall be submitted to the DGT within one month from the date of issuance of the corrigendum to the Minutes of the Meeting for consideration in the next SCAA meeting.</p>



Wiring/Electrical Workshop Space: Area expanded from 01 sq ft to 95.08 sqm, with verification for adherence to standards.</p> <p>c. Major Machinery Workshop Tools/Equipment: Provided 1 set of tools/equipment (100+ items listed); includes major items like lathe, grinder, etc., as per norms for 21-25 trainees.</p> <p>d. Lab Area/Setup: Compliant with updated 2026 norms (effective 24.01.2026); includes staff deployment and infrastructure upgrades.</p>
