Subject: Issuance of De-Affiliation Order of 08 Private ITIs of Madhya Pradesh State as considered in Standing Committee on Accreditation and Affiliation 29th (SCAA) in its meeting dated 08.05.2026- regarding.

Madam/Sir,

This is in reference to Minutes of Meeting of 11th Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Committee (SSDEC) of Madhya Pradesh State held on 15.09.2025, vide which the de-affiliation of Pvt. ITIs were recommended.

2. The matters were discussed in 29th Standing Committee on Accreditation and Affiliation (SCAA) in its meeting held on 08.05.2026 and based on the recommendations received from SSDEC, SCAA recommended de-affiliation of Private ITIs trades/units w.e.f. session 2026-27 on account of violation of affiliation norms, and same has been approved by the Competent Authority. The details of the ITIs are attached at *Annexure - I*.

3. The ITIs and the State Directorate shall ensure that all the trainees who were already enrolled in the previous session(s), complete the training duration and no fresh trainees are admitted.

In line with the principles of natural justice, the ITI was afforded final opportunity to represent itself by 26th SCAA in its meeting held on 15.01.2026 and 20.01.2026, to submit a show-cause reply explaining why the ITI should not be de-affiliated along with any supporting representation, within 21 days from the issuance of the Minutes of that Meeting due to following reasons:</p> <p>a) The inspection revealed serious deficiencies in the ITI, including availability of only an 11-month rent deed valid up to 07.03.2026 and non-submission of the building certificate. Electricity consumption for the last six months was found to be below 50 units for the entire institute, indicating poor operational activity and training quality. Essential records such as stock registers, Trainees and staffs records, daily diary, and lesson plans were not maintained. Staff payment proof, bank statements, and attendance records were not produced, while the student biometric attendance system was not implemented. Several essential machines in Lab 1 & 2 were either unavailable or non-functional due to power failure, the Electrician Lab area was short as per norms, and 05 out of 12 computers in the IT Lab were non-functional. Further, no drawing hall was available, and the roof and overall infrastructure of the ITI were found in poor condition, reflecting serious deficiencies in training facilities and institutional management.</p> <p>2. The said communication was issued by the DGT to the registered email of the institute on 06.03.2026</p> <p>3. Further, the ITI did not avail the final opportunity provided by the DGT in the 26th SCAA meeting and no reply or representation has been submitted by the ITI within the stipulated time, thereby exhibiting continued negligence and persistent non-compliance.</p> <p>4. The Committee observed that the institute, in its reply, has admitted that it has not had the requisite premises to conduct training since 2024. However, the institute made no effort to formally apply for relocation/shifting of the institute through the affiliation portal, despite the portal having remained open for inviting applications during the year 2025.</p> <p>2. Further, SCAA is of the view that the institute has deliberately avoided inspection in order to evade de-affiliation proceedings. This shows a lack of seriousness on the part of the institute towards compliance with the prescribed affiliation norms and maintenance of the minimum requirements under the CTS framework.</p> <p>3. Accordingly, SCAA decided to de-affiliate the ITI. However, the institute may apply afresh on the affiliation portal as a new ITI, if so desired, in accordance with the prevailing affiliation norms.</p>

SCAA further observed that, as per Clause 3.8 of the Affiliation Norms, 2018, change in ownership of an ITI is not permitted. In addition, shifting of the ITI premises/site location without prior approval of DGT and the State Directorate constitutes a violation of Clause 3.5 of the Affiliation Norms, 2018. Accordingly, in view of the above observations, SCAA decided to de-affiliate the ITI.
