Subject: Issuance of De-Affiliation Order of 01 Private ITI of Maharashtra State as considered in 29th Standing Committee on Accreditation and Affiliation in its meeting dated 08.05.2026- regarding.

Madam/Sir,

This is in reference to Minutes of Meeting of 5th Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Committee (SSDEC) of Maharashtra State, vide which the de-affiliation 01 Pvt. ITI was recommended.

2. The matter was discussed in 29th Standing Committee on Accreditation and Affiliation (SCAA) in its meeting held on 08.05.2026 and based on the recommendations of SSDEC, SCAA recommended de-affiliation of trades/units of 01 Private ITIs w.e.f. session 2026-27, and same has been approved by the Competent Authority. The details of the ITI is attached at *Annexure - 1*.
3. The recommendation of de-affiliation of trades & units of ITI, as mentioned in attached list must be read in conjunction with the minutes of 29th SCAA meeting issued on 01.06.2026.
4. The ITI and the State Directorate shall ensure that all the trainees who were already enrolled in the previous sessions, complete the training duration and no fresh trainees are admitted.
5. Further, the ITI is debarred from submitting any application for a period of three years from the date of issuance of this letter as per prescribed norms.

A surprise inspection of Manav Private Industrial Training Institute, Vyala, Taluka Balapur, District Akola (PR27000977) was conducted on 07.09.2022, wherein several serious deficiencies were observed, including financial discrepancies, non-appointment of a qualified Principal, unqualified Staff, lack of machinery and infrastructure, low trainee attendance, and non-maintenance of mandatory records. 2. Subsequently, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the Institute 02.12.2022. 3. The Institute, vide reply dated 16.12.2022, claimed that all deficiencies had been rectified. 4. However, during verification by the Committee on 21.07.2023, it was found that the deficiencies persisted. Major irregularities were observed such as non-production of financial records, overcharging of fees, lack of transparency in financial affairs, absence of a regular Principal, inadequate training facilities, incomplete records, absence of trainees, and change in location of trades. 5. As the deficiencies remained unrectified, a personal hearing was conducted on 31.08.2023 at 11.A.M under the chairmanship of the Director of DVET, wherein the Institute admitted to financial irregularities, collection of excess fees, and change in the approved location of trades. 6. In view of the serious deficiencies and continued non-compliance, a Final Hearing Order dated 06.11.2023 was issued for cancellation of the Letter of Intent (LOI) and de-affiliation of the Institute. Further, admissions	The matter was deliberated in the SCAA meeting, and the SCAA decided as under, based on the recommendations of the SSDEC: 1. It is observed that the ITI has committed serious violations of the prescribed affiliation norms of DGT. The Institute not only failed to rectify the deficiencies pointed out during inspection and subsequent verification, but also exhibited serious lapses such as non-maintenance of mandatory records, absence of qualified staff and infrastructure, and non-compliance with training standards. 2. Further, the matter is aggravated by the fact that during the personal hearing, the Institute itself admitted to charging training fees in excess of the prescribed limit, along with unauthorized change in location of trades. These admissions clearly establish deliberate violation of norms and lack of transparency in functioning. 3. Despite being provided sufficient opportunities through Show Cause Notice and personal hearing, the Institute failed to take corrective action. Therefore, it is evident that the Institute is not fit to continue under the affiliation framework. 4. Therefore, in view of the above remarks and in the interest of the trainees, the ITI is hereby de-affiliated.
